COVID-19 Response: If you are working to distribute resources to kids in need through an emergency program (e.g., a food bank, grab & go meal site, faith-based organization, etc.) you are eligible to sign up. If your organization would not typically qualify, but you are now providing essential resources directly to a subset of the population you usually serve (where 70% or more of those families are low-income), you are eligible to sign up. If your school, program, or community has been impacted by a recent natural disaster and you would not otherwise qualify for First Book by serving kids in need, you may be eligible to sign up for a temporary membership for disaster relief. 




First Book – Step-by-step Registration Guide for LEAs and School District Personnel

Once all required fields are filled out click "Continue" to move forward.






Estimate the number of students you serve broken down by age ranges. Your best guess is fine!
