WISCONSIN IMPACT STORY

Together, First Book and the University of Wisconsin-Madison's Literacy Link have reached thousands of children with justice-involved parents in a variety of settings through literacy-focused interactions. Books are provided in the jail visitation setting through literacy-rich resources and activities, as well as through a network of partners who work with children with justice-involved parents, including criminal justice coordinating councils, community justice services, the court system, local libraries, human services, reentry services, and schools. Activities include free book distribution, reading nooks, a recorded book reading program, parenting education, televising with an incarcerated parent at a local library, and book distribution via a book vending machine.



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
