## ALABAMA IMPACT STORY

The Alabama Department of Early Childhood Education provided books to every Pre-K child in the state to support continued learning during COVID-related closures. First Book provided title selection guidance for 2 books per Pre-K child, as well as additional books for younger siblings. Together, First Book and the Alabama Department of Early Childhood Education distributed 40,700 books to young children to help continue reading education.
