ALASKA IMPACT STORY

First Book partnered with the Alaska Native Education Consortium (ANEC), a consortium comprised of 24 schools in rural Alaska within four district partners, through the Rural Alaska Literacy Project (RAL). The RAL project supplemented multiple partnership initiatives, such as 1/2-day preschool; family engagement; Alaska Native cultural resources; and college, career, and personal/social skill development education for students within the ANEC Consortium. The RAL project enabled partner schools to supplement existing family engagement efforts by strengthening at-home libraries for predominantly low-income, Alaska Native preschool students; initiate community book lending libraries to recycle books in communities with no libraries other than within the schools; breathe new life into outdated Pre-K-12 classroom libraries by providing engaging literature for students within their classrooms.
