## CALIFORNIA IMPACT STORY

Para Los Niños creates effective, culturally appropriate programs for low-income, primarily Latinx children and families living in Los Angeles. Their model fosters pathways to success through excellence in education, powerful families, and strong communities for children and youth to thrive. Para Los Niños most recently collaborated with First Book through their Reading is Leading program — a 9-week spring reading challenge that consists of network-wide and school-specific activities — focused on reading individually, as a class, as a school, and with families. First Book was able to help support the program's goals to purchase classroom libraries for all 3 of PLN's schools, and improve students' overall literacy skills and reading confidence.
