NEW MEXICO IMPACT STORY

Roswell Independent School District partnered with First Book to amplify their work to improve literacy instruction and proficiency and develop community partnerships that they started with the Striving Readers Birth - Grade 12 federal literacy award. The partnership expanded student and family access to high-quality books for at-home and community literacy opportunities through initiatives including a winter clothing giveaway, a backpack with food initiative, a summer reading initiative, and programs for homeless and neglected youth.
