

## **SOUTH CAROLINA IMPACT STORY**

Beaufort County Schools is a longstanding, valued First Book partner, and works closely with our Special Orders team bi-annually to procure summer reading books for the students at their 31 elementary and middle schools. The county also orders copies of award-nominated titles to their students to vote on likely winners. During the school closures in 2020, Beaufort County Schools partnered with the United Way of the Lowcountry to plan Book Droop Extravaganza, an even that provided weekly home deliveries of book bags to rural children's homes where transportation to pick-up sites wasn't available.
